REVERSE round a LEFT-HAND CORNER

To turn the car around by reversing into a side-road, when the main road is too busy, obstructed, or unsafe to do a turn-in-the-road ("3-point turn")





- 1 As you drive past side road, look into it (for suitability, gradients, obstructions)
- 2 Stop a car's length beyond corner, 1/2-1 m from kerb, parallel to it, wheel straight





- 3 Check all round. Creep backwards if safe, with wheel straight, and ...
- 4 ... looking mainly through rear windscreen





- 5 When kerb appears to move away from FRONT door handle ...
- 6 ... check over right shoulder ("blind spot") for anything approaching





- 7 Steer enough left to keep distance between kerb and front door handle
- 8 Adjust steering by only ¼ turn at a time, at very low speed, to avoid ...





- 9 ... getting too close (kerb disappears under door handle), or ...
- 10 ... getting too far away (kerb disappears off edge of mirror)





- 11 When you see just straight kerb in mirror, start to straighten wheel
- 12 Get wheel fully straight by the time handles are parallel to kerb
- 13 Reverse in straight line, looking mainly back, until 3 car lengths from junction
