NORMAL POSITION

Normal distances from road edge for [1] parking, and [2] driving





Normal PARKED position—kerb meets front windscreen at SQUARE (= "Stop"). In passenger's door mirror, handles touch kerb.



Normal DRIVING position—kerb cuts windowsill at TRIANGLES (= "fast forward"). In passenger's door mirror, handles are 0.5-1.0 m from kerb.



Closest PASSING position—tyres of car meet windowsill at TRIANGLE (= "Play"), to leave a gap of min. ½m from its side. If this close, drive more slowly to give same time to react.

Parking on RIGHT—kerb cuts windowsill at TWO PIPES (= "Pause"), and right door handles touch kerb (just as when positioning "left of centre", to turn right).
