

NORMAL POSITION

Normal distances from road edge for [1] parking, and [2] driving



Normal **PARKED** position—kerb meets front windscreen at **SQUARE** (= "Stop"). In passenger's door mirror, handles touch kerb.



Normal **DRIVING** position—kerb cuts windowsill at **TRIANGLES** (= "fast forward"). In passenger's door mirror, handles are 0.5-1.0 m from kerb.



Closest **PASSING** position—tyres of car meet windowsill at **TRIANGLE** (= "Play"), to leave a gap of min. $\frac{1}{2}$ m from its side. If this close, drive more slowly to give same time to react.

Parking on RIGHT—kerb cuts windowsill at **TWO PIPES** (= "Pause"), and right door handles touch kerb (just as when positioning "left of centre", to turn right).
